Job Purpose: The Athletic Facilities Technician performs a wide variety of duties in the area of field and gymnasium maintenance and preparation for all high school sports.

Duties:

- Construct, install, and repair permanent improvements such as fences, backstops, and benches.
- Maintain football locker rooms, pressboxes, ticket booths, and concession stands. Includes cleaning and trash removal.
- Maintain turf on all playing fields and practice fields by aerating, seeding, top dressing, watering, mowing, edging, and fertilizing.
- Monitor watering of turf and ground; repair and maintenance of irrigation components.
- Ongoing maintenance and upkeep of all athletic venues.
- Prepare baseball and softball fields for games, including: dragging, lining, and setting bases, score boards, and sound systems.
- Prepare soccer and football fields for games, including: lining, scoreboards, sound systems, goals, etc.
- Prepare tennis, basketball, and volleyball courts for games, including: nets, scoreboards, and sound systems, etc.
- Coordinate venue preparation with coaching staff.
- Stock, clean, and maintain concession stands.
- Clean and maintain all ticket booths.
- Consult with Athletic Director on athletic maintenance equipment purchases.
- Report any problems or concerns regarding athletic facilities to the Athletic Director.
- All other duties assigned by the Athletic Director.

Skills/Qualifications:

- Valid Driver's License
- Minimum of a High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Ability to plan, conduct, and perform the full range of maintenance duties.
- Operate tools of the trade, such as tractors, mowers, trimmers, etc.
- Identify potential safety hazards.
- Lift, carry, drag, push heavy objects (up to 50 lbs) on a regular basis.
- Ability to maintain accurate records.
- Ability to work independently.
- Work varied shifts to accommodate athletic schedules.
- Knowledge of facility and field maintenance.
- Irrigation trouble shooting.
- Turf maintenance practices.
