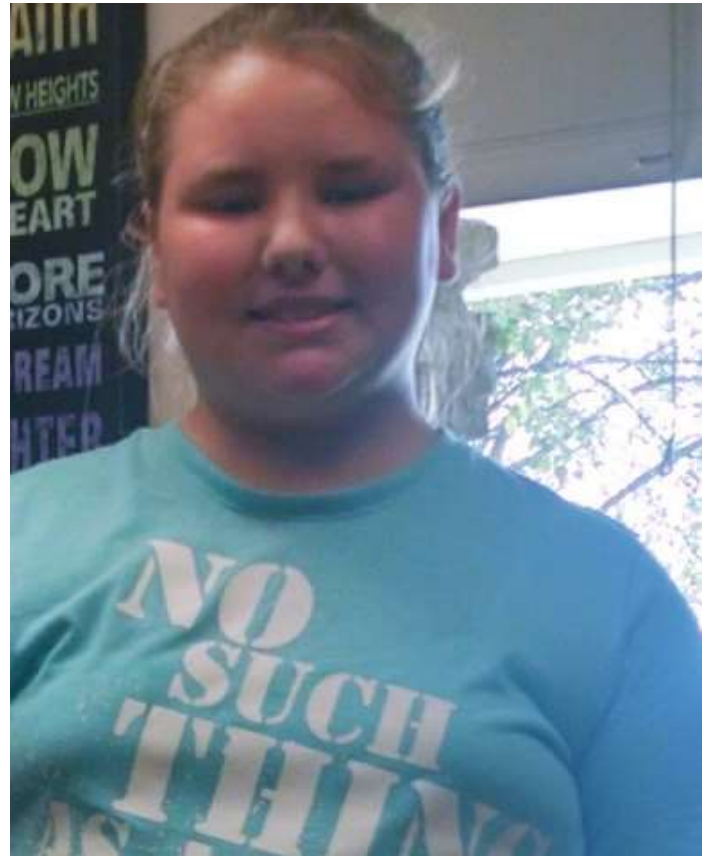




I Excel in 4-H
