Now that I have had time to process the Governors' announcement and to collaborate with other area superintendents, I am releasing, what I hope to be, the LAST revised school calendar for the 2019-20 school year. In order for teachers and administrators to prepare the paper learning packets we will use Mondays as a waiver day for students, and eLearning days on Tuesday-Friday. Starting next Monday, April 13th, this pattern will continue for the remainder of this school year. The last student day will be Wednesday, May 13.
