

FCCSC Announces Plans to Reopen

Plans are underway for the Franklin County Community School Corporation to open its doors to students on August 5, 2020. Utilizing guidance from the Indiana Department of Education, the Indiana Department of Health, and recommendations from the Franklin County COVID-19 Task Force, the administration is developing a plan that will allow students and staff to safely return to the classroom for in-person instruction on August 5th. The corporation will also provide remote learning options for families.

Details of the plan will be released in the next few weeks. The plan will include guidelines and protocols for transporting students to and from school safely, classroom instruction, movement throughout the buildings during the school day, food service, and participation in athletics and other extracurricular activities. Additionally, information will be provided for parents regarding what can be done at home to keep students and their families safe.
