FCCSC parents/guardians:

On September 1, 2021, Governor Holcomb issued Executive Order 21-24 to address the impact and spread of COVID-19. The order took effect September 2, 2021, and remains in effect through September 30, 2021.

The Franklin County Community School Corporation Board of School Trustees met on September 3, 2021 to discuss the Executive Order. As a result of this meeting, our COVID policies have changed.

The following protocols will be implemented when students return to school on September 7, 2021.

1. Face coverings must be properly worn by all students, teachers, staff, and visitors inside a school building and on the school bus.
2. Individuals who are identified as a close contact DO NOT have to quarantine, but should monitor for symptoms.
3. This DOES NOT apply when a person tests positive OR the close contact is unmasked for any reason.
4. This DOES NOT apply to lunch, or students in band or choir. It does not apply to athletics and extracurricular activities. Students that are close contacts and are contract traced in these situations must quarantine. Six feet social distancing will be used when face coverings are not worn.
5. Close contacts in an outdoor setting during the school day such as recess will not be contract traced nor require a required quarantine.
6. Fully vaccinated individuals or anyone who has had COVID in the last 90 days DO NOT need to quarantine if they have no symptoms.
7. The parent/guardian will be notified if a child is a close contact.
